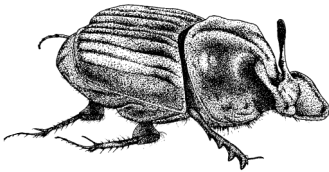


# Dung Beetles, Buffalo Fly & Pestivirus
